#### **Force**

We can describe a force only by its effects. It cannot be measured directly like a length. A force can start something moving. If we push against a small object it moves. A force can also stop something moving or hinder motion. If we brake a moving car it slows down and will eventually stop. Suspend a heavy mass from a copper wire. The wire extends, showing the a force can stretch a body. Forces may also compress, bend or even break an object.

A force can be one of attraction. The force of attraction exerted by the huge mass of the earth is called gravity. If we pick up a stone, then release it, it falls to the ground because of gravitational force. Gravity is an example of a natural force Whether a force is naturally or deliberately exerted it cannot exist by itself. Forces must always occur in pairs, never in isolation.

When a force acts on a rigid body it is balanced by an equal reaction force which acts in the opposite direction. If a mastands on a slippery surface and brings a force to bear on a heavy load, the reaction force makes him slide backwards.

Similarly if a man fires a rifle, the force which pushes the bullet forwards will be matched by a force which makes the gun push backwards against his shoulder.
